Membership Rules and Regulations

- A. Membership requirements
 1. HRC Board Members reserve the right to limit memberships
 2. Memberships are available on an annual basis with prorated rates for those joining mid-year.
 3. Any member shall be permitted to resign at any time by notifying the board members in writing. Such resignation will be effective on the last day of the month in which the resignation was submitted and dues will be paid accordingly.
 4. Members who resign their membership will need to pay the difference for reinstatement within 12 months following such resignation.
 5. Members must maintain US rowing waiver on an annual basis
- B. Payment of dues and indebtedness:
 1. Dues shall be due and payable monthly – due on the first day of the month. If the payment of such dues is not made on or before the 5th day of the month, HRC board members may agree to suspend or cancel the membership of such delinquent member. Cancellation of membership shall not relieve such delinquent member from liability for all monthly dues incurred prior to date of cancellation of such membership, or for liability for all indebtedness owed to HRC.
 2. For 2019, dues are \$40 per month for individuals, and \$50 per month for a family. Dues will be re-evaluated on a yearly basis. Visitors can pay a \$10 daily fee.
- C. Meetings
 1. Members are expected to attend the annual club meeting, usually held in March
 2. The annual meeting includes updates for yearly plans as well as voting opportunities
- D. Safety
 1. As a member of HRC, it is expected that all safety guidelines are followed, especially:
 - a. Abide by all safety rules in the “Safety Rule Document” found on the website.
 - b. Notifying either your emergency contact or a club member that you are going out on the water

- c. Everyone must get approval with safety officer (once) before taking a boat on the water
 - 2. Members new to rowing require safety approval by safety officer for usage of single shells and must include flip test.
 - I am new to rowing
 - I have rowing experience
- E. Equipment
 - a. Members must log equipment usage in logbook
 - b. Members must review checklist before and after rowing
- F. Members must agree to abide by the HRC SafeSport Policy posted on the HRC website
- G. The club president is the primary point of contact with Warrior's State Park and is a board member of the Friend's of Warriors State Park. Other than immediate safety concerns, members will route all questions and concerns for Park Management through the club president.
